AN ACT

To amend and reenact R.S. 17:233(B)(1) and to enact R.S. 17:233(C), relative to school attendance; to provide for the circumstances under which a student shall be considered habitually absent or tardy; to require a student's parent or legal guardian to enforce school attendance; to impose penalties upon the parents or legal guardians of students in certain grades who are habitually absent or tardy; to provide for definitions; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S. 17:233(B)(1) is hereby amended and reenacted and R.S. 17:233(C) is hereby enacted to read as follows:

§233. Cases of habitual absence or tardiness referred to juvenile or family court

\* \* \*

B.(1)(a) A student shall be considered habitually absent or habitually tardy when either condition continues to exist after all reasonable efforts by any school personnel, truancy officer, or other law enforcement personnel have failed to correct the condition after the fifth unexcused absence or fifth unexcused occurrence of being tardy within any school semester.

1 (b) The parent or legal guardian of a student shall enforce the attendance of  
2 the student at the school to which the student is assigned.

3 (c) The principal of the school, or his designee, shall notify the parent or  
4 legal guardian in writing upon a student's third unexcused absence or unexcused  
5 occurrence of being tardy, and shall hold a conference with such student's parent or  
6 legal guardian. The student's parent or legal guardian shall sign a receipt for such  
7 notification.

8 (d) The parent or legal guardian of any student in kindergarten through grade  
9 eight who is considered habitually absent or habitually tardy pursuant to the  
10 provisions of this Section shall be in violation of the provisions of Subparagraph (b)  
11 of this Paragraph and shall be punished as follows:

- 12 (i) A first offense shall be punishable by a fine of not more than fifty dollars  
13 or the performance of not less than twenty-five hours of community service.
- 14 (ii) Any subsequent offense shall be punishable in accordance with R.S.  
15 17:221(A)(2).

17 C. For purposes of this Section, the term "tardy" shall include but not be  
18 limited to leaving or checking out of school unexcused prior to the regularly  
19 scheduled dismissal time at the end of the school day but shall not include reporting  
20 late to class when transferring from one class to another during the school day.
